

### Message from the Principal

A big thank you to our staff who stayed back late last night for our 'meet the teacher' evening and to everyone who was able to come along.

Awesome effort to GROW who made the event a perfect community one with a free sausage sizzle, pedal-mania and the bouncy castle. Everyone had a wonderful time.

Today a paper notice is going home for a school picnic day at Foster Park on Friday 02 March. We hope families can come along and attend this too. We are trying to stream-line our communication so that any paper notices that need to go home (requiring permission) are sent home on a Thursday, the same day as our community newsletter is emailed home. So, a Thursday is a good day to check your email and school bags! Generally, most studios are also emailing home a 'what's coming up in our studio' weekly on a Sunday or Monday.

Our leadership team have also spent some time over the holidays trying to forward plan extension to the curriculum events or extra curricula events and trips for the year so that you will have an idea of the projected costs.

As you know our philosophy is to keep costs to a minimum for families which is why our BOT has a zero donation policy. However, we have to pay the costs for all of these events and we have not been funded for them. The predicted costs for extension to the curriculum events (trips, swimming lessons, Arts performances) for learners in Years 1-4 is approx. \$100 for the year.

The cost for seniors is obviously higher with Camp, BYOD (optional) and Technology lessons at Lincoln (Y7/8). The learning that occurs for our children on these extension to the curriculum events is often invaluable and what our learners say they love when we review their thoughts and opinions on their schooling experiences. I urge families to consider setting up direct debit payments so that an amount can be paid weekly to enable participation.

### Year 8 2018 School Based Vaccination Programme

We are pleased to inform you the Canterbury DHB will continue to offer a School Based Vaccination Programme to Year 8 boys and girls, who have not completed their eleven year old vaccinations in General Practice. The School Based Vaccination programme will offer the two dose HPV vaccinations to protect against genital warts, cervical cancer, throat and mouth cancers, and other types of cancers later in life. In 2018 the programme has been extended to include a one dose Boostrix vaccination to provide protection against Tetanus, Diphtheria and Whooping Cough. To enable students to receive the vaccinations at school, a vaccination pack will be sent home in Term 1. Parent/ Caregiver will need to complete and return the consent form to school.
